For those who don't want to stay put and live new year's eve at its fullest Istiklal Caddesi, Ortakoy or Bebek is where to go. Famous side streets of Taksim's which is car-free are packed with small bars and pubs that offer cozy and lively entertainment. But be prepared for the crowd of the famous Istiklal Caddesi. Ortakoy and Bebek have fewer bars to offer but tend to be serene and are since they are on Bosphorus shores better located to see the fireworks.



A Place To Lost In ISTANBUL ARCHAEOLOGY MUSEUMS




Istanbul Archaeological Museums are a compound of museums that consist of three major sections; The Archaeology Museum, The Museum of the Ancient Orient, and The Tiled Kiosk Museum. These three separate main units are located in the same garden and house the palace collections formed during the late 19th century by Osman Hamdi Bey. Osman Hamdi Bey was the museum director, a master painter ("The Tortoise Trainer" / Pera Museum), and a renowned archaeologist that discovered many of the artifacts in the museum himself. Istanbul Archaeological Museum is the first museum in the history of the Ottoman Empire and in Turkey, has about a million artifacts from a variety of cultures, brought from the imperial lands.

Istanbul Archaeological Museum is one the leading museums in the world. Its collection of artifacts pulls the interest of millions of visitors every year both domestic and foreign. Even a full day-long visit wouldn't be enough to absorb all of its splendor. The museum has a large collection of Turkish, Hellenistic, Mesopotamian, and Roman artifacts, many gathered from the vast former territories of the Ottoman Empire. The most prominent artifacts that marveled at the most are; The Alexander Sarcophagus, the Sarcophagus of the Crying Women, the Tabnit sarcophagus, The Lycian sarcophagus of Sidon, the Sarcophagus of Sidamara, the tile images from the Ishtar Gate of Babylon, the laws of king Ur-Nammu, Treaty of Kadesh and thousands of more that are strikingly impressive ancient works of art.

The complex is located in the Sultanahmet neighborhood, the historical peninsula of the Fatih district; on the Osman Hamdi Bey slope, which connects Gülhane Park with the Topkapı Palace Museum. The Istanbul Archeology Museum complex can be easily reached. It is open seven days a week between the hours of 9.00 AM to 7.00 PM.



THE TILED KIOSK (MUSEUM OF ISLAMIC ART)

The Tiled Kiosk was built by the Ottoman Sultan Mehmed II in 1472 as a pleasure palace or a kiosk. Since 1953, the building serves as a museum of Turkish and Islamic art. The pavilion contains many important examples of İznik tiles and Seljuk pottery.

(A remarkably well-preserved late 4th century BC Hellenistic stone sarcophagus)



Sarcophagus of Sidamara (World's largest sarcophagus weighing 32 tons)



Sarcophagus of the Crying Women (Represent women weeping for the death of their King, and the funeral march)



The Tabnit Sarcophagus (The sarcophagus of the Phoenician King of Sidon Tabnit I)



Treaty of Kadesh (The earliest known surviving peace treaty)
