

The Ancient City of **OLYMPOS**



The province of Antalya offers many ancient sites to visit. One of the most popular is Olympos. You can visit the archaeological site of Olympos and stay in bungalow style, wooden houses in pine forests, and orange groves. It's a beautiful place for a nice getaway.

THE ANCIENT CITY OF OLYMPOS

The city of Olympos was founded around the 3rd century BC. The ruins are located near the beach, at the mouth of a river. If you start your visit to the city from the right, you will see a sarcophagus belonging to Captain Eudomos. There is an inscription dedicated to Eudomos on it that you shouldn't miss.

ACTIVITIES IN OLYMPOS

Around the site, it is possible to do some trekking, canyoning, climbing, and various sea sports. The area is on the Lycian Way and offers some very nice trekking routes. This place is also one of the breeding areas of the world-famous Caretta Caretta turtles in our country.

OLYMPOS CABLE CAR

The cable car that goes up and down the hill is the most popular activity in Olympos. You will be amazed by the sensational panoramic views. You can also join in exciting activities on the top of Mount Olympos.

Olympos Beach

Located in the middle of the nature reserve, the pebble beach impresses with its beautiful and unique atmosphere in the middle of ancient ruins.



YANARTAS

Chimera was a mythological animal with the head of a lion, the body of a goat, and the tail of a snake. About 8 km from Olympos, is the ancient volcano of Chimaera, where gases escaping from fissures in the rocks produce an ever-burning flame. This place is called burning rock, Yanartas in Turkish.

PAMUKKALE

A Delicate Cotton Beauty

Turkey hosts epic natural beauties and Pamukkale is at the top of the list. World famous, listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List Pamukkale Travertines are attracting millions of tourists every year, with its thermal pools and reminiscent of huge cotton fields travertines. You and your social media followers will be amazed by the photos you take in Pamukkale. As if its pure white beauty is not enough to make Pamukkale a place to visit, the Ancient City of Hierapolis is right next to it.



Pamukkale Travertines

Pamukkale travertines are located in the Denizli province of Turkey. Pamukkale, with a distance of 18 kilometers, is easy to reach from the city center. Even from afar, this limestone plateau offers a dazzling view to its visitors. When you get close you'll see the snow-white stalactites sparkle in the sun, while shallow pools of thermal water reflect the bright blue sky.


Deep in the earth, beneath Pamukkale lies a vast amount of water heated by volcanic lava. From the hot springs, the bursting mineral water rich with calcium carbonate forms the beautiful travertines. The water has been bursting in Pamukkale for thousands of years. And these hot springs are very popular health tourism attractions. There are various thermal pools in Pamukkale where visitors can spend time in the relaxing waters. The Romans build the city of Hierapolis as a spa city to use its health benefits and the beauty of travertines just came with it.

The ruins of Hierapolis, the Roman spa town on the top of the travertine mountain, are among the interesting places in Pamukkale. The Ancient City of Hierapolis is also on the UNESCO World Heritage List, just like the travertines. This very well preserved antic city has many sites to visit and ancient hot spring pool is still can be used.

The ancient city of Hierapolis, located on a plateau above limestone terraces, also means "holy city" and it dates back to the 2nd century BC. In ancient times, these thermal pools were extremely famous, and people flocked to the city to bathe in the hot springs of Hierapolis, hoping that it would improve their medical conditions, just like now. Among the ruins; There are castle ruins, a Byzantine church, Necropolis, walls, a columned street, and the Hierapolis theater. Make sure to visit Hierapolis ruins when you are in Pamukkale!

HIERAPOLIS MUSEUM

This small but excellent museum dedicated to Hierapolis is located inside the ancient Roman bath of the ancient city. In this museum, you can revive the ancient city in your eyes.



HIERAPOLIS THEATER

On a hillside above the rest of the Hierapolis ruins is a large theater with a façade over 100 meters long, built by Roman Emperor and has managed to survive to the present day.

ANCIENT POOL

The ancient pool was formed naturally after the collapse of the columns and the accumulation of thermal water in the earthquake that occurred in Pamukkale in 692 AD. This magnificent ancient pool offers a different experience with its 36-degree water that does not change for all four seasons.

There is nothing better than a Turkish Coffee after a delicious Turkish meal.




YAYLA SOUP (MEADOW SOUP)

Yogurt soup cooked with a variety of herbs (mint, purslane, parsley and others). A light soup perfect for a full Turkish meal.




KARNIYARIK
